## RULES

Please see the General Rules for a complete list of rules.

1. It is the responsibility of every teacher or ensemble conductor (to become familiar with the rules and regulations because they will be adhered to through-out the festival.
2. All competitions, unless otherwise stated, shall be open to any competitors without regard to domicile, provided they are residents or students in the Province of Nova Scotia or study virtually with a teacher in our catchment area.
3. All entries must be fully completed on the appropriate entry form. A separate entry form must be used for each class.

4. All competitions, unless otherwise stated, shall be open to amateurs only. Professionals may enter the classes marked "Senior/Open", except in senior provincial classes.
5. In like classes, participants may enter in one class only (e.g. if you enter Grade 1 List A, you are not allowed to enter Grade 2 List A). However, you may enter Grade 1 List A and Grade 2 List B because they are different categories.
6. All classes have both a Competitive (C) and a Non-competitive (NC) option. Please indicate "for comments only" on your registration form if you would like to be non-competitive.
7. Eligibility for all trophies and prizes is determined by the results of Competitive classes.
8. Concert Attire is required for competitors and accompanists for both test classes and "Stars of the Festival" Concerts. Performers are encouraged to treat all classes like a public performance and wear appropriate attire.
9. In classes where an age limit is set, the competitor shall not be over the specified age limit as of December 31st of the previous year.
10. In Own Choice classes, each competitor chooses their selection, keeping in mind the quality and standard of the music. Where time limits are stated, competitors must adhere to the rules. The score MUST HAVE NUMBERED MEASURES. Markings do not need to be erased.
11. All Own Choice selections must be listed on the entry form; TBA selections will not be accepted.
12. Participants, parents and teachers are not permitted to go to the adjudicator's desk to speak to the adjudicator at any time.
13. In all Concert Group or Own Choice classes, selections must not have been performed by the contestant in another class in the current Festival or in the Festival of the previous year.
14. In duet or duo classes, one competitor may not perform the same part twice.
15. Any contestant wishing to enter the Festival, who cannot find a class to accommodate his/her/their musical instrument or group should contact [syllabus@avmf.ca](mailto:syllabus@avmf.ca) or call us at 902-385-3378 (FEST). Your request will be considered by the Festival Committee.
16. Outstanding participants of the Festival will be selected by the Adjudicators to perform in the "Stars of the Festival" concerts.

17. If a selection exceeds the time limit specified in the syllabus, the contestant may be stopped by the Adjudicator.
18. Competitors must check in 15 minutes before the class is scheduled to begin. Their music should be well marked and left with the front of house staff.
19. At the conclusion of each class the Adjudicator may announce the marks of the top three competitors only. Comments may be general or individual, at the Adjudicator's discretion.
20. A contestant requesting to play at another time than the designated time of the class , unless a conflict exists between classes entered in the festival, **will be marked as a Non-competitive entry.**
21. **COMPETITORS MUST SUPPLY SCORES FOR THE ADJUDICATORS**, which they must hand in prior to the classes in which they are performing during live festivals, or via email to [info@avmf.ca](mailto:info@avmf.ca) as a pdf at the time of registration for virtual festival. If no music is supplied, five marks may be deducted.
22. **NO PHOTOCOPIES FOR ADJUDICATOR, PERFORMER OR ACCOMPANIST ARE PERMITTED**, unless accompanied by a letter of consent from the copyright owner or publisher. A performer using a photocopy will be disqualified. Downloaded music is permitted provided proof of purchase is supplied.
23. If contestants wish to be eligible for the Provincial Festival they must enter the required class (es) as stipulated in the syllabus for their instrument or voice.
24. Competitors are asked to notify the festival ([info@avmf.ca](mailto:info@avmf.ca)) or 902-385-3378 (FEST) of any cancellation at least 24 hours in advance.
